## The Good Shepherd [John 10:11-18]

1. Jesus comes to us with \_\_\_\_\_.

*“He who is a hired hand and not a shepherd, who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees, and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. <sup>13</sup> He flees because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep.<sup>14</sup> I am the good shepherd.”* JOHN 10:12-14a ESV

2. Jesus leads us to \_\_\_\_\_.

*“The sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.”* JOHN 10:3 ESV

*“The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.”* JOHN 10:12 ESV

*For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life that I may take it up again. <sup>18</sup> No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This charge I have received from my Father.”* JOHN 10:17-18 ESV
