

WHAT JESUS SAID ABOUT HELL

Thirteen percent of the 1,850 verses in the New Testament that record the words of Jesus deal with the subject of eternal judgment and hell.

ROBERT JEFFRESS, *OUTRAGEOUS TRUTH*

1. Hell is a place of
'And if your eye causes you to sin, tear it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into hell, 'where their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.'" MARK 9:47-48
"The angels will come out and separate the evil from the righteous and throw them into the fiery furnace. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of reeth." MATTHEW13:47-50 ESV
Both (only found in 1 Peter 3:9) are equivalent to hell and the lake of fire but different from hades, the emporary place of departed spirits.
2. Hell is a place.
'I tell you, many will come from east and west and recline at table with Abraham

Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven, while the sons of the kingdom will be

thrown into the outer darkness." MATTHEW 8:11-12; 22:13

"Cast the worthless servant into the outer darkness." MATTHEW 25:30 ESV

And the angels which did not stay within their own position of authority, but left their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains under gloomy darkness until the judgment of the great day. JUDE 6 ESV

3. Hell is a place where
They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might. 2 THESS. 1:9 ESV
On earth, believers and unbelievers experience MATTHEW 5:24
4. In hell, there will be
"In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." MATTHEW 13:42, 8:12, 22:13, 24:51, 25:30; MARK 9:18

The Final Judgment of Unbelievers

Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. From his presence earth and sky fled away, and no place was found for them. And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done. Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. REVELATION 20:11-15 ESV
