Day 1 - Friday, February 14: Depart U.S.A.

Embark upon your journey with an overnight flight to Tel Aviv. Prepare yourself for a life-changing experience and get some rest on the flight. Tomorrow you will be walking in the footsteps of Jesus.

Day 2 - Saturday, February 15: Arrive in Tel Aviv

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, arrange your own transportation to the hotel, located on the beautiful coast of the Mediterranean Sea. If you have time, you might want to stop off in Old Jaffa, the traditional home of Simon the Tanner and the port from which Jonah sailed to Tarshish.

Day 3 — Sunday, February 16: Caesarea, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Nazareth, Cana, Galilee

After a delicious breakfast, we depart for the Galilee to visit biblical sites at Caesarea Maritima, where Peter proclaimed the Good News to a Roman Centurion (Acts 10). Next, we visit Megiddo, overlooking the Jezreel Valley (the site of the future Battle of Armageddon) and Mt. Carmel, where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Then, we continue to Nazareth (Jesus's childhood home) and Cana (location of Jesus's wedding miracle, John 2). We arrive in Tiberias for dinner and overnight near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – Monday, February 17: Galilee, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Primacy of St. Peter, Ancient Boat, Sea of Galilee Boat Ride, Magdala, Jordan River Baptisms

Nothing compares to watching the sunrise over the Sea of Galilee. We begin today reflecting and worshipping at the Mt. of Beatitudes and then head toward Capernaum, Jesus's base for His early ministry. Then, we visit Tabgha (traditional site of the feeding of the 5000) and the Church of Primacy of St. Peter. Our lunch stop includes the option of ordering the special St. Peter's Fish (cost not included). After lunch, we visit an ancient boat believed to be from the time of Jesus, found in the Sea of Galilee in 1986. Then, we board a replica wooden "Jesus boat" to set sail ourselves on the Sea of Galilee. Next, we visit Magdala to see another ancient synagogue that dates to the time of Christ. We end our day at the Jordan River for an optional baptism. We return to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner at Magdalena and overnight near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Tuesday, February 18: Mount Arbel, Beit Shean, Jerusalem, Mount Scopus, Shepherd's Field, Manger Square, Church of the Nativity, Bethlehem

After breakfast, we start the day with a visit to Mount Arbel



for a spectacular view of the Sea of Galilee and the Plain of Gennesaret. Then, we head south to Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities. This is where King Saul and his son's bodies hung from the city walls after the Philistines defeated the Israelites (1 Samuel 31:10-12). Then, get ready to ascend the breathtaking holy city, Jerusalem, remembering the Songs of Ascent (Psalm 120-134). We stop at Mount Scopus for a magnificent view of Zion. Next, we stop for lunch at the Tent Restaurant (cost not included) on our way to Shepherd's Field, where we remember the Christmas story. We finish the day with a visit to Manger Square and the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem. That afternoon, we check into the exquisite King David Hotel, where we enjoy dinner and spend our first night in Jerusalem.

Day 6 – Wednesday, February 19: Guest Speaker, City of David, Israel Museum, Model City, Memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem

Following breakfast, we begin the day with a private lecture at the King David Hotel with Dr. David Sedaca of Chosen People Ministries and Hebrew University before we depart for the City of David to view the archeological evidence that reveals what life was like during the reigns of Israel's greatest kings, David and Solomon. After lunch, we will visit the Israel Museum and view the fascinating 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem as it would have appeared in Jesus' time. Next, we will visit the Memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem, followed by some free time to explore the city on your own, or enjoy the pool and spa (cost not included) at the hotel. After dinner, enjoy the Night Spectacular Sound & Light Show at the Tower of David Fortress, and then return for a luxurious night of rest at the King David Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 7 — Thursday, February 20: Temple Mount, Western Wall, Western Wall Tunnel, Church of St. Anne, Pool of Bethesda, Mount of Olives, Palm Sunday Walk, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Shabbat Dinner

After breakfast, we begin the day visiting the Temple Mount, the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25), and the place where Abraham built an altar to sacrifice his son Isaac (Genesis 22). This area is also the third holiest shrine in Islam, where we will find the El-Aqsa Mosque and the magnificent Dome of the Rock. From there we enter Jerusalem through the Zion Gate and proceed to the Western Wall Tunnel to see the excavations that are taking place there. We enter the Old City through the St. Stephen's Gate (Lion's



Gate) to the Muslim Quarter, visit the beautiful and acoustic Church of St. Anne, and the Pool of Bethesda. Later we enjoy a magnificent view of the Old City from the Mount of Olives, enjoy the "Palm Sunday Walk," visit Dominus Flevit Chapel and weep with Jesus, and then stop for prayer and reflection in the Garden of Gethsemane. We return to the King David Hotel in Jerusalem for a special private dinner, with final words from Dr. Ron Jones and a time to share our memories, plus overnight rest.

Day 8 — Friday, February 21: St. Peter Gallicantu, (Caiaphas's House), Southern Steps, Upper Room, Old City, Via Delarosa, Church of the Holy Sepulcher, Garden Tomb

We begin our final day of touring in Jerusalem at St. Peter Gallicantu (Caiaphas's House), make our way to the Southern Steps of the Temple, and then arrive at the Upper Room. We enter the Old City at Stephen's Gate (Lion's Gate) through the Muslim Quarter and walk along the Via Delarosa. We experience Stations of the Cross and visit the Sisters of Zion where we see the pavement where Jesus stood while Pilate put Him on trial. Along the way we see the Ecce Home Arch and the Ancient Cardo. Then, we visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, followed by some free time in the Old City for shopping. We finish touring with a visit to Golgotha (Gordon's Calvary) and the empty Garden Tomb, with a special communion service. After a day of touring, we attend a private Shabbat dinner in an authentic Jewish home with a local host family. After dinner, return to the spectacular King David Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 9 — Saturday, February 22: Depart Israel, Arrive in U.S.A.

In the early morning, we will transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight back to the U.S.A. We arrive back in the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour. We take home a renewed faith, confidence in the Holy Scriptures, wonderful memories with friends, and a fresh understanding of the life and ministry of Jesus Christ.

Day 9 – Saturday, February 22: Jerusalem, Tel Aviv for Flight to Cairo, Flight to Luxor

We depart Jerusalem and continue to Ben Gurion Airport for our short flight to Cairo. Upon arrival, we meet our Egyptian representative and tour guide. Then we change planes for a short flight to Luxor, which is known as the "Heart of Egypt." Depending on flights, time permitting we will begin our sightseeing with a tour of classical Luxor, the East Bank, which includes the Luxor Temple. Dinner and overnight are in Luxor.

Day 10 – Sunday, February 23: Luxor, Valley of Kings & Queens, Temples of Medinet Habu, Hatshepsut, Felucca Boat Ride on Nile River, Temple of Karnak

After breakfast, we begin our sightseeing of the West Bank to see the Valley of the Kings and Queens, Medinet Habu Temple, Hatshepsut Temple, and Colossi of Memnon. We will then cross back to the east side of the Nile River on a felucca boat and enjoy a late lunch (included) at Sonesta Luxor Hotel. We then end the day with a visit to the massive Karnak Temple. Dinner and overnight in Luxor.

Day 11 – Monday, February 24: Cairo, Egyptian Museum

Following breakfast, we drive to the Luxor Airport for our flight back to Cairo. Our sightseeing tour of Cairo includes a wonderful visit to the world-famous Egyptian Museum. This new museum contains unbelievable artifacts from the past, including the treasures of King Tutankhamen. If you wish, you will have time to also visit the mummy room (for an extra fee). We then drive to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Cairo.

Day 12 — Tuesday, February 25: Memphis, Sakkara, the Pyramids, Sphinx

Following breakfast, we drive to Memphis, the capital of the Old Kingdom of Egypt. We see the Alabaster Sphinx and an impressive statue of Ramses II. Nearby, we'll include a visit to the Necropolis of Sakkara, containing the funerary monuments from various periods of Egyptian history. We view the Step Pyramid of King Zoser and several mastabas (tombs of nobles), including the tombs of Ti and Ptah, some of the most notable excavations of Egypt. After lunch, we visit the Great Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. You will have the opportunity to go into one of the pyramids. We will also enjoy a panoramic view of the pyramids, and if you like, on the back of a camel (not included). We return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 13 – Wednesday, February 26: Depart Cairo, Arrive Back in the U.S.A.

We transfer early in the morning to Cairo International Airport for our flight home.

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration.

<u>Credit cards are only accepted for the initial deposit.</u> All other remaining payments must be made in the form of a check, including final payment. Final payment is due no later than 100-days prior to departure. Registrations received after 100-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. Registrations received between 90-75 days prior to departure are subject to a \$300 late fee.

Tour pricing is based on a minimum group size of <u>26 passengers to be valid</u>. The following supplements may apply for smaller groups: 20-25 travelers, \$100 per person; 19-15 travelers, \$150 per person; 14-10 travelers, \$195 per person. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be canceled due

to lack of participation.

If final (full) payment is not received by *imagine* Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) 75-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply. *imagine* reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (11/15/23) when your tour was booked by your tour leader (church, All payments are required in US was booked by your tour leader/church. ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While imagine will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 75 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single** room supplement charge of \$1,455 for the basic itinerary; \$985 for the optional Egypt extension.

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, imagine reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/ or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to imagine no later than 100days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. All tours are final at 70-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.

Land Only price is \$5,530 per person. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, imagine does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. *imagine* also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 100 days prior to departure. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *imagine*. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. *imagine* is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers. CANCELLATION FEES:

Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administrative fee per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 75 days prior until the date of departure.

The following charges also apply: 99-75 days = \$500; 74-55 days = \$2,750; 54-41 days = 85% of total cost; 40 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. All cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.
