### Day 1 – Friday, June 16: Depart U.S.A.

Tour members make their own flight to Israel. After dinner is served, it's time to sit back, relax, enjoy the journey to the Holy Land, and prepare for the experience of a lifetime.

### Day 2 – Saturday, June 17: Arrive in Tel Aviv (Mediterranean Sea)

In Tel Aviv (Ben Gurion Airport), we proceed through customs and meet an imagine Representative. We have a short drive to our hotel, located on the beautiful coast of the Mediterranean Sea, where we enjoy dinner and overnight in Tel Aviv.

### Day 3 – Sunday, June 18: Caesarea, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Nazareth, Cana, Galilee

After a delicious breakfast, we depart for the Galilee to visit biblical sites at Caesarea Maritima, where Peter proclaimed the Good News to a Roman Centurion (Acts 10). Next, we visit Megiddo, overlooking the Jezreel Valley (the site of the future Battle of Armageddon) and Mt. Carmel, where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Then, we continue to Nazareth (Jesus's childhood home) and Cana (location of Jesus's wedding miracle, John 2). We arrive in Tiberias for dinner and overnight near the Sea of Galilee. We also check-in to the Gallelujah Festival.



### Day 4 – Monday, June 19: Galilee, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Primacy of St. Peter, Ancient Boat, Sea of Galilee Boat Ride, Magdala, Gallelujah Festival

Nothing compares to watching the sunrise over the Sea of Galilee. We begin today reflecting and worshipping at the Mt. of Beatitudes and then head toward Capernaum, Jesus's base for His early ministry. Then, we visit Tabgha (traditional site of the feeding of the 5000) and the Church of Primacy of St. Peter. Our lunch stop includes the option of ordering the special St. Peter's Fish (cost not included). After lunch, we visit an ancient boat believed to be from the time of Jesus, found in the Sea of Galilee in 1986. Then, we board a replica wooden "Jesus boat" to set sail ourselves on the Sea of Galilee. We end the afternoon exploring the pre-70 A.D. synagogue at Magdala. We remain in Tiberias for dinner and overnight near the Sea of Galilee, and we enjoy our first night of the Gallelujah Festival.

### Day 5 – Tuesday, June 20: Mount Arbel, Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Golan Heights, Gadara, Bethsaida, Gallelujah Festival

After breakfast, we start the day with a visit to Mount Arbel for a spectacular view of the Sea of Galilee and the Plain of Gennesaret. We then head north toward Mt. Hermann to embark on a short hike through Tel Dan to visit the altar of Jeroboam. Then, we make our way

to Caesarea Philippi to visit the temple to the god Pan called Panaeon. It is also the place where Peter confessed to Jesus. "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16). After lunch at a quaint Druze Café (cost not included), we travel north to the Golan Heights for a beautiful view of northern Israel's landscape. We finish the day at Gadara (where Jesus healed the demoniac) and, time permitting, Bethsaida. We return to Tiberias to enjoy our second night of the Gallelujah Festival.

Today is your FREE DAY to create your own special experience in the Galilee. Choose from a variety of Gallelujah activities (gallelujah.com/activities). Raft on the Jordan River, join an archeological dig, hike the "Jesus Trail," attend ancient Galilee arts & crafts workshops, take a jeep tour or an off-road motorbike ride, swim in the Sea of Galilee, enjoy a relaxing massage, and more. Lunch is included on this special day. Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight, where we also enjoy our third and final night of the Gallelujah Festival.

### Day 7 – Thursday, June 22: Beit Shean, Jericho, Masada Ahava Factory, Dead Sea

After breakfast, we begin the day in Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities. This is where King Saul and his son's bodies hung from the city walls after being defeated by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10-12). Afterwards, we drive via the Jordan Valley and past Jericho on our way to the Dead Sea. Along the way, we scale Masada, ascending by cable care to the top to see King Herod's mighty fortress. Then, we visit the Ahava Factory for shopping before we arrive (by 3pm) at our evening destination for a swim (float) in the Dead Sea or enjoy the spa. Dinner and overnight are at our hotel by the Dead Sea.

### Day 8 – Friday, June 23: Ein Gedi, Qumran, Jerusalem, Mt. Scopus, Bethlehem, Shepherd's Field, Manger Square, Church of the Nativity

After breakfast, we depart the Dead Sea to visit Ein Gedi, a popular oasis where King David also hid from King Saul in the nearby caves. From there, we continue to Qumran, the settlement of the Essenes and the place where the Dead Sea scrolls were discovered in 1947. Then, we ascend to the majestic city of Jerusalem, remembering the Songs of Ascent (Psalm 120-134), and land upon Mt. Scopus for a view of the Holy City. After lunch at the Tent Restaurant (cost not included),

we visit Shepherd's Field to remember the Christmas story from Luke chapter 2. Then, we visit Manger Square in Bethlehem and the Church of the Nativity. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 9 – Saturday, June 24: Temple Mount, Western Wall, Western Wall Tunnel, Church of St. Anne, Pool of Bethesda, Mount of Olives, Palm Sunday Walk, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane**

After breakfast, we begin the day visiting the Temple Mount, the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25), and the place where Abraham built an altar to sacrifice his son Isaac (Genesis 22). This area is also the third holiest shrine in Islam, where we will find the El-Aqsa Mosque and the magnificent Dome of the Rock. From there we enter Jerusalem through the Zion Gate and proceed to the Western Wall and the Western Wall Tunnel to see the excavations that are taking place there. We enter the Old City through the St. Stephen's Gate (Lion's Gate) to the Muslim Quarter, visit the beautiful and acoustic Church of St. Anne, and the Pool of Bethesda. Later we enjoy a magnificent view of the Old City from the Mount of Olives, enjoy the "Palm Sunday Walk," visit Dominus Flevit Chapel and weep with Jesus, and then stop for prayer and reflection in the Garden of Gethsemane. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 10 – Sunday, June 25: St. Peter Gallicantu, (Caiaphas's House), Southern Steps, Upper Room, Old City, Via Delarosa, Church of the Holy Sepulcher, Garden Tomb**

We begin our final day of touring in Jerusalem at St. Peter Gallicantu (Caiaphas's House), make our way to the Southern Steps of the Temple, and then arrive at the Upper Room. We enter the Old City at Stephen's Gate (Lion's Gate) through the Muslim Quarter and walk along the Via Delarosa. We experience Stations of the Cross and visit the Sisters of Zion where we see the pavement where Jesus stood while Pilate put Him on trial. Along the way we see the Ecce Home Arch and the Ancient Cardo. Then, we visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, followed by some free time in the Old City for shopping. We finish touring with a visit to Golgotha (Gordon's Calvary) and the empty Garden Tomb, with a special communion service. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 11 – Monday, June 26: Ben Gurion Airport (Tel Aviv)**

In the early morning, we will transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight back to the U.S.A. We arrive back in the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour and with a hallelujah in our hearts. We take home a renewed faith, confidence in the Holy Scriptures, wonderful memories with friends, and a fresh understanding of the life and ministry of Jesus Christ.

**Day 11 – Monday, June 26: Allenby Bridge, Mt. Nebo, Macharus, Petra**

We begin the day by driving south to the Jordan Valley the Allenby Bridge. Here we make the crossing from Israel to Jordan. After border formalities, we meet our Jordanian guide and bus and drive to Mt. Nebo to stand where Moses stood and viewed the Holy Land (Deut. 34). Here you can take in a breathtaking view across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea. We continue to Macharus, one of Herod's palace-

fortresses. It was here where John the Baptist was beheaded (Mark 6). In the late afternoon, we drive south down the Desert Highway to Petra, where we spend the night. We arrive at our hotel and enjoy a late dinner together.

**Day 12 – Tuesday, June 27: Petra, Wadi Rum**

We arrive this morning at the entrance of Petra and spend the entire day within this red-rose ancient city. We are in the heart of the Seir Mountains, Land of Edomites, mentioned in the Bible in Genesis. These mountains house the Aaron Peak, the highest in Petra and the burial place of Moses' brother Aaron. A walk through the Siq, the main entrance to Petra, brings us to the first monument "The Treasury" "Al-Khazneh" a dramatic site. This well-preserved monumental tomb appears in the movie "Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade." A walk further down through the outer siq with alfof its tombs and burial chamber brings us to one of the largest theaters in Jordan. A 3000-seat theater from the early first century is carved in the sandstone mountains at the bottom of the High Place of Sacrifice Mountain. Apparently, some sacrificial rituals had taken place here. From here, we walk uphill to the Royal Tombs for a great view of the lower part of Petra with all its Roman remains. There will be the option to walk to the "Monastery" of Petra and/or the High Place. Leaving the site of Petra in mid-afternoon, we drive south to Wadi Rum. Here we enjoy an amazing jeep ride in the desert. We then stay in Wadi Rum at Captain's, a Bedouin Village. We enjoy dinner together and a devotional time under the stars. It will be a unique experience!



**Day 13 – Wednesday, June 28: Wadi Rum, Amman**

Late morning start, we leave Wadi Rum and make our way for Amman, where we then check into our hotel for our farewell dinner and time to rest and shower as we have an early morning transfer to the Amman Airport for our return flight back home.

**Day 14 – Thursday, June 29: Amman, Arrive in U.S.A.**

We have an early morning transfer to Alia Airport for our return flight back to the U.S.A. We arrive home in the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour. We take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life of our Lord.
