Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. PSALM 51:1 ESV

2. _____ up!

For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. ⁴ Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment. ⁵ Behold, I was brought

forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. ⁶ *Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.* PSALM 51:3-6 ESV

For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. ⁴ *For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.* ⁵ *I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.* PSALM 32:3-5 ESV
