

## SET APART AND SENT OUT: PAUL'S FIRST MISSIONARY JOURNEY



Like Elijah who fled to \_\_\_\_\_\_ after he defeated the prophets of Baal on Mount Carmel, zealous Saul traveled to the same region and spent three years there before returning to Damascus. [SEE GALATIANS 1:11-24]



Now there were in the church at Antioch prophets and teachers, Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen a lifelong friend of Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. <sup>2</sup> While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to
